

PRIVACY POLICY

The protection of your personal data is particularly important to us ("dr. Alessandro Dobrilla", "us", "we"). We therefore process your data exclusively on the basis of the statutory provisions.

By reading this you declare to have understood and you consent to use this site.

1. Personal data

Personal data is all data that contains individual details about personal or factual circumstances, such as name, address, e-mail address, telephone number, date of birth, age, gender, social security number, video recordings, photos, voice recordings of people and biometric data such as fingerprints. Sensitive data such as health data or data in connection with criminal proceedings can also be included.

We collect, process and use your personal data only with your consent or mandate or order for the purposes agreed with you or if there is another legal basis in accordance with the GDPR; this in compliance with data protection and civil law provisions.

Only such personal data is collected that is necessary for the implementation and processing of the advisory services, in compliance to other relevant laws (i.e. anti money laundering, tax purposes), or that you have made available to us voluntarily.

2. Information and deletion

As a client or as a person concerned in general, you have the right to information about your stored personal data, its origin and recipient and the purpose of the data processing as well as a right to correction, data transfer, objection, restriction of processing and blocking or deletion of incorrect or impermissibly processed data at any time - while maintaining the legal confidentiality obligation.

If there are changes to your personal data, we ask you to notify us accordingly.

You have the right to revoke your consent to the use of your personal data at any time. Your input for information, deletion, correction, objection and/or data transfer, in the latter case, provided that this does not cause a disproportionate effort, can be sent to our address below.

If you are of the opinion that the processing of your personal data by us violates the applicable data protection law or your data protection claims have been violated in any other way, you have the option of complaining to the responsible supervisory authority.

3. Data security

Your personal data is treated with the aim to protect it by appropriate organizational and technical precautions. These precautions relate in particular to protection against unauthorized, illegal or accidental access, processing, loss, use and manipulation. Regardless of the efforts to comply with a consistently high level of due diligence, it cannot be ruled out that information that you provide to us via the Internet will be viewed and used by other people.

Please note that we and the persons who eventually work for us therefore assume no liability for the disclosure of information due to errors in data transmission not caused by the us and/or unauthorized access by third parties (e.g. hack attack on email account or telephone, interception of faxes).

4. Use of the data

The data made available to us will not be processed for purposes other than those covered by the mandate contract or by your consent or by a provision in accordance with the GDPR. An exception to this is use for statistical purposes, provided the data provided has been made anonymous.

5. Transmission of data to third parties

In order to fulfill our mandate, it may also be necessary to forward your data to third parties (e.g. counterparties, substitutes, insurance companies, service providers used by us and to whom the data is made available, the tax Authority, etc.), courts or authorities. Your data will only be forwarded on the basis of the GDPR, in particular to fulfill our mandate or based on your prior consent which you guarantee to us when you request for our services.

Furthermore, we inform you that in the context of legal representation and support, factual and case-related information is regularly obtained from third parties.

Some of the above recipients of your personal data could be located outside your country or process your personal data there. The level of data protection in other countries may not correspond to that in Italy.

6. Notification of data breaches

We make every effort to ensure that data breaches are recognized at an early stage and, if necessary, reported to you or the responsible supervisory authority without delay, including the respective data categories that are affected.

7. Retention of data

We will not store the data longer than is necessary to fulfill contractual or legal obligations and to defend against any liability claims.

8. Cookies

This website uses "cookies" to make the offer more user-friendly, effective and secure.

A "cookie" is a small text file that we transfer via our web server to the browser's cookie file on your computer's hard drive. This enables the website to recognize you as a user when a connection is established between our web server and your browser. Cookies help to determine the frequency of use and the number of users of this website. The content of the cookies used is limited to an identification number that no longer allows any personal reference to the user. The main purpose of a cookie is to recognize visitors to the website.

Two types of cookies are used on this website:

- Session cookies: These are temporary cookies that remain in the cookie file of your browser until you leave the website and are automatically deleted at the end of your visit.
- Permanent cookies: For better user-friendliness, cookies remain stored on your end device and allow your browser to be recognized on your next visit.

You can set your browser so that you are informed about the setting of cookies and only allow cookies in individual cases, exclude the acceptance of cookies for certain cases or in general and activate the automatic deletion of cookies when the browser is closed. If cookies are deactivated, the functionality of this website may be restricted.

9. Server log files

In order to optimize this website in terms of system performance, user-friendliness and the provision of useful information about our services, the provider of the website automatically collects and stores information in so-called server log files, which your browser automatically transmits to us. This

includes your internet protocol address (IP address), browser and language settings, operating system, referrer URL, your internet service provider and date/time.

A combination of this data with personal data sources is not carried out. We reserve the right to subsequently check this data if we become aware of specific indications of illegal use.

10. Google analytics

This website uses functions of the web analysis service Google Analytics. The provider is Google Inc., 1600 Amphitheater Parkway Mountain View, CA 94043, USA.
